

<u>Year 2</u> <u>Autumn Term 2</u> November - December 2023

Science

This half term we will be learning about 'Growth and Survival', with animals including humans. Children will learn to what animals and humans need to survive and have a healthy life. We will also look at animals environments and humans as they grow older.

Physical Education

In PE we will be learning about fundamental movement skills. Children will practice body management, locomotor skills and object control.

English

This term we will be reading and doing work around the 'The Lost Wolf', a take on the Red Riding Hood tale illustrated with humour. The children will write poems, character descriptions and letters around this story.

We will also be continuing with RWI phonics.

Mathematics

Over the next half term we will be exploring money, they will read and recognise different coins and notes, being able to use the £ and p symbol correctly. We will also be looking multiplication and division, children will aim to learn the 2,5 and 10 times table this term.

<u>History</u>

In our 'Guy Fawkes and the gunpowder plot' topic, we will find out who Guy Fawkes was and what why he carried out the gunpowder plot. We will also explore bonfire night and understand why fireworks are lit on November 5th.

Religious Studies - Come and See

In the first few weeks of this will be learning about Islam, we will be learning about the Muslim family and how they pray at home. We will then be celebrating the time of Advent by learning about preparations and the run up to Christmas.

In our 'Toy Chestnut' topic we will be begin to look at beat, rhythm, melody, echo, call-and-response, tuned and untuned percussion. We will look at recognising and play echoing phrases by ear. We will also continue to have hymn practice each week.
