

Year 2 Spring Term 2 February - March 2024

Science

This half term we will be learning about plants. Children will be exploring plants that grow from seeds, we will investigate what they need to grow and how to grow some plants of our own.

Physical Education

In PE we will be learning athletic skills and taking part in yoga. On Tuesday lunchtime KS1 children have the opportunity to do dance club with myself. Our PE days this term are Monday and Wednesday.

English

In English we will be looking at the book Secret Sky Garden, where Fuuni, a little girl, creates a secret garden on top of an abandoned high rise car park to create some peace within the city. We will also be continuing with RWI phonics.

Mathematics

Over the next half term we will be exploring the properties of 2D and 3D shapes and finding lines of symmetry. We will then learn about fractions exploring the whole ½ and ¼. Please keep engaging with Timetable Rockstars as this will begin to secure their 2,5 and 10 timetables.

History

In History this term we will be exploring our Monarch, looking at the lives of previous and future Kings and Queens. We will be learning about Queen Elizabeth I, Queen Victoria and King Henry VIII. Children will look at chronology to understand that different people are born at different times.

Religious Studies - Come and See

At the beginning of the term we will be exploring the Eucharist, Eucharist means thanksgiving and therefore we will use this to explore being thoughtful for life, for people and gifts, as this is a vital part of our relationships with one another. We will then start our Easter topic exploring how we can be self giving everyday. The children also take part in daily collective worship, this is a time for the children to reflect and respond.

P.S.H.E.

We are looking at 'relate' over the next few weeks. We will learn about our relationships with our friends, family and people in the community. Children will learn about active listening and how to use their own character strengths to help them relate to others.

Computing

In our 'computing services and networks' topic we will be learning how to touch type on a keyboard and navigate a computer.

Design Technology

This term children be using textiles to make puppets. We will research about different types of puppets and how they are made, before going on to design and make their own. Children will learn how to sew using running stitch and investigate joining material together.

Music

Orawa describes a huge river. As pupils listen to the music, they will imagine the journey of the river through Europe. They will make a huge piece of art based on the river's journey and then, borrowing ideas from the composer, invent new music using vocal chants and body percussion.
